- Show the steps of taking the individuals red medical book and putting it in the particular individuals (Go Kit bag)
- Once Staff have the individuals ready, have their medications and medical book packed, and have their Go-Kit ready
  - > Take all of the individuals to the car.

## **GO KIT CONTENTS:**

- 1. Each individual's medications, including PRN
- 2. Red Medical Binder for each individual
- 3. 2-sets of clothing undergarments for all individuals and staff
- 4. Personal items (toothbrush, deodorant, hairbrush, etc.)
- 5. All adaptive equipment for individuals (with 1 extra battery)
- 6. 1- towel and wash cloth for each individual
